EXHIBIT REGULATIONS

1. Use of Exhibit Space

Exhibitors agree not to assign or sublet any space al- lowed to them without written consent of Exhibit Man- agement to display or advertise goods other than those manufactured or carried by them in the regular course of business.

No persons firm or organization not having contracted with Exhibit Management for the occupancy of space in the exhibit will be permitted to display or demonstrate its products, processes or services, distribute advertis- ing materials in the halls, corridors, or in any other way occupy or use the facilities for a purpose inconsistent with the regulations.

2. Damage

Exhibitors will be liable for any damage caused by their activities including damages caused by fastening fix- tures to doors, walls or columns of exhibit building and for any damage to equipment furnished by Exhibit Man- agement service suppliers designated by it or exhibit facility. Exhibitors shall indemnify and hold ASCE (in whole sections, officers, et el) harmless from all claims and liability for such damages.

3. Admission to the Exhibits

Admission to the exhibits will be by invitation or badge, to be prescribed by Management and to be utilized to the best interest of the exhibitor to assure a quality au- dience.

4. Exhibitor Personnel

Each exhibitor will furnish the Exhibit Manager in ad-vance, the names of those who will staff the booth. Exhibitor badges will be furnished to only those so named. Personnel will be admitted to the booth one hour before the opening. In the event that earlier ad- mission is required, special permission must be ob- tained from the Exhibit Manger. Exhibitor's badges are restricted to personnel employed by the company re- serving exhibit space.

5. Compliance

The exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulation and codes of duly authorized local, state and federal governing bod- ies concerning fire, safety, health, together with the rules and regulations of the operators, lessors and/or owners of the property wherein the exhibit is held. The exhibitor agrees to strictly observe all Federal, State and local laws, including the Americans with Disabilities Act. Cloth decorations must be flameproof. Wiring must comply with fire department and underwriters rules.

6. Liability


The exhibitor shall take all precautions to protect the public against injury. The American Society of Civil Engineers, the Queen Mary, the designated service contractors and their agents or employees shall not be responsible for any loss, theft or damage to the proper- ty of the exhibitor, his employees or representatives. Further, Exhibit Management will not be liable for dam- age or injury to persons or property during the term of this agreement from any cause whatsoever by reason of the use or occupancy of the exhibit space by the exhibitor or his assignees, and the exhibitor shall in- demnify and hold harmless Exhibit Management and the Queen Mary from all liability which might ensue from any cause whatsoever. Specifically, the exhibitor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Ameri- can Society of Civil Engineers and the Queen Mary and agents from all damages and claims of damages that may arise because of any negligence, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance by the exhibitor, its em- ployees, agents, and contractors and against all loss because of the failure of the exhibitor in any respect to perform all of its obligations under this contract. If the exhibitor's materials fail to arrive, the exhibitor is nevertheless responsible for all amounts due hereunder. Exhibitors are advised to carry special insurance to cover exhibit material against damage and loss and public liability insurance against injury to the persons and property of others.

7. Cancellation or Termination of Exposition

In the event that the premises where the exposition is to be held shall, in the sole determination of Exhibit Management, become unfit or unavailable for occupancy, or shall be substantially interfered with, by reason of pick- eting, strike, embargo, injunction, act of war, act of God, fire or state of emergency declared by any government agency or by reason of any municipal, state or federal law or regulation or by any reason of any other occur- rence beyond the control of Exhibit Management, Ex- hibit Management may cancel or terminate the exposi- tion. In the event of such cancellation or termination, the exhibitor waives any and all claims the exhibitor might have against Exhibit Management for damages or expenses and agrees to accept in complete settlement and discharge of all claims against Exhibit Management the exhibitor's prorate share of the total amount paid by exposition including a reserve for future claims and expenses in connection therewith.

If Exhibit Management shall for any reason determine to cancel or terminate the exposition, the exhibitor waives all claims the exhibitor might have against Ex- hibit Management a refund of all amounts paid by the exhibitor to Exhibit Management in accordance with this agreement.
